If you do not have access to a computer with a printer at home, you may use one in the H.S. library (or at the Fairfield public libraries). The application requires a PDF reader, if you do not have Adobe Reader (or Acrobat), a link for a free (and safe) download is available. Once you have completed the form you may save the file to your home PC or to your student folder at school for your records. *The deadline to apply is April 25, 2014*.
