Application now available to The High School Scholarship Foundation of Fairfield

The HSSFF is a not for profit foundation that generously provides financial assistance for post-secondary education to graduating seniors at Fairfield's public high schools. It is governed by a community based all volunteer board of directors.

All seniors received a letter I homeroom outlining the application instructions. The application is available online at <http://fairfieldschools.org/scholarship-2014.htm>. The application must be filled out completely AND PRINTED. Be sure to complete it on a device that has access to a printer. If you do not have access to a computer with a printer at home, you may use one in the H.S. library (or at the Fairfield public libraries). The application requires a PDF reader, if you do not have Adobe Reader (or Acrobat), a link for a free (and safe) download is available. Once you have completed the form you may save the file to your home PC or to your student folder at school for your records. ***The deadline to apply is April 25, 2014.***

Act NOW to apply for the CHET Advance Scholarship.

The Spring 2014 CHET Advance Scholarship provides up to 100 \$2,500 scholarship awards to high school juniors who attend college by September 2016. Winning juniors will be chosen on a random basis. **The deadline for submitting an application is 5:00 P.M. EST on April 30, 2014.**

To determine if you meet the eligibility requirements, students should go to www.chetadvance.com and submit an on-line application. Juniors must upload a school transcript. Students should see their School Counselor to obtain a copy of their transcript.

The names of eligible students will be placed into the appropriate category of juniors and Congressional Districts, from which winners will be selected randomly in the Drawings. CHET Advance Scholarship winners will be notified in writing by e-mail sent to the email address provided on the application.
