1787 – The newly drafted Constitution of the United States of America is signed by 38 of 41 delegates to the constitutional convention in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The document then required ratification by nine of 13 states to become law.

WHO GETS IN AND WHY?

The School Counseling Departments at both high schools are pleased to bring you a new college admissions program this year. This is the Tufts application workshop - an interactive experience that reveals the inner

workings of an admissions office. Tufts will explain the factors considered in the admissions process, look at real applications, and let you act as a member of the admissions committee and vote on who should be accepted. While Tufts will serve as the case study, the lessons of Who Gets In and Why apply to any highly selective admissions process. The workshop will show how you can best distinguish yourself in college applications.
