 - Log in with your 6 digit student ID number (if you have a 5 digit number, put a zero in front of it)
- From you Mobile Device:
 - Download the *OverDrive Media Console*
 - Enter your zip code and choose Fairfield Public Schools
 - Follow the set up directions for the Adobe Digital Reader
 - Log in with your 6 digit Student ID number (if you have a 5 digit number, put a zero in front of it)
