- ✓ Pick a school you would like to sign up for.
- ✓ Select "sign up"
  - O You will now see the details for the college visit.
- ✓ Select "Sign me up" if you would like to attend this college visit.

- ✓ After you select "Sign me up", you will see a confirmation notice.
- ✓ Print this page, which is your pass.
- ✓ Bring the pass to your teacher and ask them to sign it.

- ✓ Remember to sign the attendance sheet at the information session otherwise you will receive a cut from your class.
