The four schools represent a very diverse group of colleges: Tufts, Union, UCONN, and Springfield College. The presenters have experiences at a number of colleges and varied backgrounds. Their comments—while specific to their individual schools—will also give parents and students an insight into admissions at similar schools and the entire application and admissions process.

After their presentations they will answer questions from parents and students.
