

2015 FWHS Senior Prom Information and Event Agreements

The Fairfield Warde High School Senior Prom will be held on Saturday, May 30, 2015 at Vazzano's Four Seasons in Stratford, CT. The dance will be from 7:00 P.M. until 11:00 P.M. A full dinner buffet, including dessert will be served.

Tickets are **\$55 per person** and will be sold starting Monday, May 18th through Friday, May 22nd in the small gym at Miss Kirchhof's office. **There will be no extension of ticket sales.** Students can choose their seating with up to 10 people at each table. When purchasing tickets as a table, have one representative from the group bring the table sheet form along with permission slips and payment for *all students* at the table. Tickets can also be purchased individually. Please note that you do not need a date to attend the Senior Prom and every year many students come individually or as a group of friends. Seating will be assigned for those coming in groups smaller than ten.

Please be aware that you may not purchase a ticket for the prom if you have any outstanding textbook, library, or athletic department obligations, as well as disciplinary issues. If you are unsure whether or not you have any obligations or issues please see your dean, LMC staff, or the athletic director.

If you are taking a guest from another school, please have the Guest Form filled out completely.

SENIOR PROM AGREEMENT (FWHS Students)

The Senior Prom is an event planned and organized by students in the Class of 2015 and their advisors, sponsored by FWHS, to help foster fun and class spirit in a safe and wholesome environment. Students and their guests who attend this function are expected to abide by all school rules and policies that govern student behavior. *Use of alcohol or any other behavior altering substance before, during, or in any way associated with this function is strictly prohibited.* Failure to abide by this agreement will result in school disciplinary action and may also result in loss of privilege to attend other senior class events including graduation.

Fairfield Board of Education policy requires that all students attending the dance take a breathalyzer test. Any student who fails the test will be denied admittance and will be subject to the consequences outlined in the alcohol and substance abuse policy. Students may also be breathalyzed upon exiting the dance.
