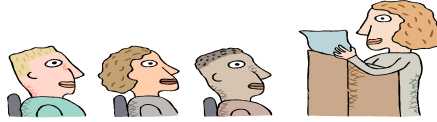




“LIFE AFTER HIGH SCHOOL-TRANSITION TOPICS TRAINING SERIES”
