## Oct. 21<sup>st</sup> Rehearsal Make-Up Assignment-Due 7 Class Days After Missed Rehearsal

- Find out from your section leader or a peer what we worked on during the rehearsal. List the items below. Add more in the space below "c" if needed. Also, be specific: write things like measure numbers, page numbers, "by memory," etc. when possible.

- 2. Practice each item at home until you can complete it with 95% accuracy. For example, if we sang the whole piece by memory, practice until you can do so with only a few errors. If we worked on dynamics, practice singing the piece with the correct dynamics until you achieve 95% accuracy.
- 3. Record yourself singing 2 of the items we rehearsed (in their entirety). If we sang something by memory, you please need to make a video recording. Otherwise, an audio recording is fine. *Mrs. Verney-Fink has both a camera and a recording device you can use if needed. Just see her and she can let you take one or both to a practice room to use.* 
  - a. Note: These recordings should demonstrate 95% accuracy. Please re-record if you made a lot of mistakes, did not show the items we were working on, etc.
    This should be treated like a final product.
  - b. If the song is a cappella, record with no background accompaniment. If the song has piano, you should...
    - i. Sing with a practice track that was put on the choir website.
    - ii. If that's not available, you should either look it up on youtube to have something to sing to in the background, or ask Mrs. Verney-Fink for help.
