FWHS offers a full range of academic courses including 25 AP courses, 8 courses in the UCONN Early College Experience Program, 37 varsity athletic teams, artistic, dramatic, and musical programs, and a wide range of student organizations and activities. Students may also participate in the Bridgeport Regional Vocational Agricultural School and the Regional Center for the Arts. FWHS is accredited by the Connecticut State Department of Education and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges.

Fairfield, CT is located 50 miles from New York City and is home to two universities. Fairfield's over 60,000 residents are mostly well educated and fall into a high-income demographic. The per-pupil expenditure for the 2014-2015 school year was \$17,220.


