It may also extend to parents and of alcohol by a minor on property they own or are in control of must make reasonable efforts to halt not provide the alcohol.

This means, the person in control and liable:

- doesn't have to be present,
- doesn't have to be aware of the drinking
- doesn't have to be an adult
- DOES have to attempt to stop any drinking

Consequences

Violation includes but is not limited to:

- ✓ A fine of up to \$2,000 and/or imprisonment
- ✓ Minors may be fined and their driver's license papuadsns
- If any of the minors are under the age of 16, 'risk of injury' may be charged. This is a FELONY.
