OUR SCHOOL and COMMUNITY

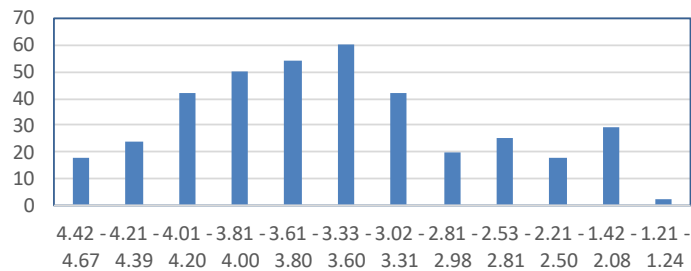
Fairfield Warde High School is a comprehensive public high school serving 1487 students in grades 9-12. FWHS offers a full range of academic courses including 25 AP courses, 9 courses in the UCONN Early College Experience Program, taught by highly qualified teachers, as well as 35 varsity athletic teams, artistic, dramatic, and musical programs, and a wide range of student organizations and activities. Students may also participate in the Bridgeport Regional Vocational Agricultural School and the Regional Center for the Arts. The per-pupil expenditure for the 2016-2017 school year was \$17,063. FWHS is accredited by the Connecticut State Department of Education and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges.



Fairfield, CT is located on the Long Island Sound, 50 miles from New York City and is home to two universities. Fairfield's 61,000 residents are mostly well educated and fall into a high-income demographic.

SUBJECT LEVEL GROUPING

Students are homogeneously grouped in English, mathematics, science, social studies and world languages based on test scores, past achievement, teacher and counselor recommendation.

Advanced Placement: College level courses.

Level 1: Honors courses: second digit of course number is designated a 1 (e.g. 31).

Level 0: All courses heterogeneously grouped: second digit of course number is designated a 0 (e.g. 10).

Level 2: Rigorous college preparatory courses: second digit of course number is designated a 2 (e.g. 32).

Students take a 60 level or AP.
