The FPS Science Department will be hosting a trip to the Galapagos Islands off the coast of Ecuador in the spring of 2020! Any former Biology FLHS or FWHS student are invited!!!!

The plan involves walking in Darwin's footsteps to the following islands: Isabela, Santa Cruz, and San Cristobal Islands. While there we will observe giant tortoises, finches, and mocking birds that helped solidify Darwin's theory of natural selection. On mainland Ecuador, the discoveries are more culturally oriented at Quito's Independence Plaza, Intinan Museum and Otavalo.
