American Red Cross Blood Drive: Students 17 and older will volunteer to donate blood under the supervision of the American Red Cross and with signed consent of a parent or guardian in the form of THIS permission slip ONLY.

Preparation: Students must do the following:

- Drink extra fluids the day before your donation.
- Be sure to eat before you arrive.
- No strenuous exercise before or after donating.
- Do not drink hot liquids, smoke or chew gum just prior to donating.
- Wear comfortable clothing.
- Relax.
- Photo ID required.

#### General guidelines for blood donation

- Be in good general health and feeling well.
- Be at least 17-years-old
- Weigh at least 110 pounds.
- Have not donated blood in the last 56 days.
