## Graduation 2019

**Date:** June 14, 2019

**Time:** 6:00 PM

**Place:** FWHS Main Courtyard

**Rain Location:** FWHS Main Gym - The decision to move to the rain location will be made by 3:00 pm on June 14. Notice of this will be on the FWHS web site [fairfieldschools.org/schools/fwhs/](http://fairfieldschools.org/schools/fwhs/) and Infinite Campus. Additional instructions will be given to the graduates at the rehearsal on June 14.

**Tickets:** Each family will receive four (4) tickets for admission to the ceremony in the courtyard (or gym if inclement weather). Each family will also receive 2 tickets for additional seating in the auditorium for a live broadcast. Tickets will be distributed to students at rehearsal on June 14. Extra ticket requests must be placed at the following link: [bit.ly/WardeExtra](http://bit.ly/WardeExtra) no later than May 3 and will be granted on a space available basis. No phone requests will be honored.

**Caps and Gowns:** Will be distributed to students at rehearsal on June 13. All financial obligations must be fulfilled.

**Rehearsals:** Rehearsals are mandatory.

June 14 9:30 - 12:00 FWHS Auditorium

**Attire for the ceremony:** Boys - White collared shirt, school tie (provided), slacks and appropriate footwear  
Girls – Dresses, skirts, or slacks and top and appropriate footwear

**Prohibited items:** Beach balls, silly string, noise makers, air horns, etc. Use of items such as these detracts from the ceremony and the ability of all in the audience to see and hear.


**Special Accommodations:** Families in need of wheelchair seating are asked to inform us no later than June 7. Please call Nancy Rice at 203 255-8354.
