Dear Fairfield Warde Families:

During the first year of the Fairfield Public Schools <u>Innovative Learning Initiative</u>, we completed a rollout of Chromebooks for students in Grade 7 at the middle schools and Grades 9-12 at the high schools. This initiative provided both students and teachers the tools to enable access to learning anytime and anywhere.

This letter is to provide information regarding End-Of-Year and Summer Procedures for families.

Grades 9, 10 & 11

Option A: Parents would like their students to bring their devices home for the summer and the devices remain as "checked out" in the FPS management system. (Please review the Summer Care information below).

• There are a wide variety of online resources to extend their learning opportunities over the summer using these online resources. Students can access educational resources such as: the High School Summer reading program, ClassLink, library resources and Overdrive.

Option B: Parents <u>who do not wish</u> to have their students take the devices home over the summer should have their children return the devices.

• Return dates will be June 10-13 between 8 - 12:15pm in T - 24. Students **must** directly have the Chromebook checked in and cannot leave until it is scanned in by staff.

Summer Care:

- Please review the <u>Student Chromebook Care Guidelines</u> to ensure that the devices are properly cared for over the summer.
 - On'ts: Bring your device to the beach, leave it in hot parked car, or leave the Chromebook plugged in for extended periods of time.
 - Do's: Turn-off the Chromebook on a weekly basis so it may receive updates, store the device in a cool and dry location.
- Summer Tech Help Desk
 - o Step 1: Fill out the FPS Chromebook Service Request Form
 - Step 2: Bring it so the following location:
 July 1 26: Roger Ludlowe Middle School (Summer School Location) 9:00 am 1:00 pm
 July 29 August 9: 501 Kings Highway East Suite 210 (Main FPS Offices) 9:00 am 1:00 pm .
 No technical assistance from August 12 Start of School. Devices will still be monitored.
