Fundraiser Overview

- 1. Show the brochure to any friends, relatives, or neighbors who might enjoy a good pie!
- 2. Collect orders and payment between now and Friday, September 23. (There is no tax)
- 3. On Saturday, November 19th pick up the frozen pies in the cafeteria and deliver to our supporters!

Remember, these pies can be kept frozen, used during the <u>Thanksgiving</u> and <u>December</u> Holidays, or baked anytime company drops in!

Order Form and Payment Directions

- 1. Copy down supporters name, phone and order on order form.
- 2. Calculate total number of pies and total cost.
- 3. Collect payment.
- 4. Thank Supporter, and repeat steps one to three.
- 5. When finished selling, tally total pies sold and total money collected.
- 6. Double check that the money collected matches cost of pies.
- 7. Place check and order form in an envelope labeled PIE SALE.
- 8. Sending in one check for the entire order is most preferred.

Please mark your calendar today!! The pies come frozen, and should be delivered to the purchasers as soon as possible. We have no facilities to store the pies, so it is important to make sure your orders are picked up on November 19th. At the pie pick-up day you will receive your original ORDER FORM so you can properly distribute pies to your supporters.

Please understand that any pies which are ordered and paid for, but are not picked up on Saturday, November 19, will be resold if possible, or donated to Operation Hope on Saturday afternoon.

Our goal is for each student to sell 5 pies. (Many students will sell 20 to 30 to 40 pies!)

Students: for every 5 pies you sell, your name will be entered in a \$50.00 drawing.

You will ALSO get to draw a "Prize Pencil" with a cash prize attached, ranging from \$1 to \$20.

There will be two \$50 Grand Prizes: one for the person selling the most pies and one from our drawing.
