Dear Parents,

Each year, the Fairfield Woods Music Department sponsors a Pie Fundraiser to support yearly field trips for our students. It not only provides these special opportunities for them, but also brings you and others delicious frozen pies that can be saved and used for any special occasion.

**Directions**

1. Write down the name and phone number of the supporter on your worksheet.
2. Fill in how many pies they would like for each flavor on your worksheet.
3. Remember to collect the payment from your supporter for the correct amount.
4. When finished collecting orders, tally them on the worksheet.
5. Add the total number of pies and write that number in the correct box on your order envelope.
6. Calculate the total cost and write that amount in the correct box on your order envelope.
7. Make sure all of the directions have been followed on both your worksheet and order envelope.

**Picking up your pie order:**

On the morning of Saturday, November 18th, all of the pies will arrive in the FWMS Cafeteria. We ask that you come to the cafeteria between 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM to pick up your order. **Don't forget to bring your worksheet with you.** The pies will be set up by flavors. We will help you in getting the correct flavors and amounts needed for your order. When you have all of your pies, we will provide a final check and you will be all set to deliver your pies to your supporters. Please understand that any pies which are ordered and paid for, but are not picked up on November 18th will be either resold or donated to Operation Hope that afternoon. We do not have a facility that can store frozen pies.

**Our goal:**

We would like each student to sell 5 pies. Many students have sold 20-40 pies each year!

**Prizes**

- For every 5 pies a student sells, their name will be entered in a \$50 drawing. Also, that student will draw a "Prize Pencil" that is wrapped with a cash prize ranging from \$1 to \$20.
- There will be two \$50 grand prizes: one for the person who sells the most pies, and one from the drawing.
