

## PERFORMANCE NOTES

The Hebrew text, beginning at m. 38, is excerpted from "The Song at the Sea," a passage from the Book of Exodus which recounts the story of the parting of the Red Sea. This choral arrangement uses an Anglicized, phonetic spelling of the text, in order to assist the chorus in more accurately pronouncing the language. The English translation is as follows:

*A-shi-ra l'A-do-nai ki ga-oh ga-ah.*

I will sing to the Lord, for He has triumphed gloriously.

*Mi-cha-mo-cha ba-e-lim A-do-nai.*

Who is like You, oh Lord, among the celestial.
