
Homeroom - Please bring a book each day.


Mr. Sorbello is Team

Ms. Krahe is the Math teacher on our team. She is very passionate and will do whatever it takes to make sure students reach their full potential!




Mr. Krushinski is the Social Studies teacher on the team. You will have fun exploring different regions of the world and learning about many different cultures!
