Thank you for informing the school regarding your child's upcoming extended absence. The school appreciates your communication; however, we would like to remind you that, according to district policy and state law, this is not a school approved absence. As a parent, be aware that according to the district policy, you and your child are responsible for all class work and homework missed during this absence. This policy is outlined for you in the Student/Parent Handbook section of your child's student agenda.

Depending on the course and teacher's plans, classroom assignments completed during the absence may not be available from the teacher prior to leaving. There is no way that a teacher can compensate for what is being missed in the classroom or group interaction and teachers cannot develop individual lesson plans for each student. This is especially true before and after extended weekends, and the December, winter and spring recesses where a large number of requests are placed on teachers for the work which will be missed.
