### HH Construction Update

Thank you to everyone who attended the neighborhood meeting for our construction project on November 9<sup>th</sup>. At this meeting, the phases of the construction were presented by the architect and construction manager. We also presented the project at the most recent Town Planning and Zoning Meeting.

The first official step of the project involves moving the portables from behind the gym to the front of the school. They need to move because they are currently on the footprint of the new construction site. They are home to Occupational and Physical Therapy, as well as Gifted Education. Their new location will be right next to the two white portables housing 5S and 5M. These will be ready for occupancy again on January 4, and they will remain in their new location until the construction project is finished.

While the portables are out of commission, Mrs. Ferrara will work with her students in the library, and Mrs. Rhoades and Mrs. Provost will push into classrooms to work with their students. Thank you to these staff members for their flexibility!

Right now, it looks like our official start date for the actual construction is March 22! Much more information will follow as that date gets closer! It is an exciting time for HH!
