<u>Arrival</u>

As you know there are two ways we can arrive at school based upon the weather. The default for arrival is at the outside door of the classroom. The rationale is linked to safety and efficiency. It is much quicker to get the students in and less traffic flow if large crowds are not all traveling down the same hallways. However, on days where the weather is inclement or the blacktop areas are unsafe, we call indoor line up. Indoor lineup has the K-2 students go to the cafeteria and the 3-5 students to the gym. If you arrive at school and are wondering where to go, feel free to ask a staff member. Supervision begins at 8:45 and they would be happy to direct you.
