Carloop Signs

In a continued effort to improve safety and security, we are introducing signs for the families who usually pick up their children in our Carloop. The sign will also assist our staff in being efficient when dismissing the children. The signs will be distributed throughout this week at dismissal. The initial distribution list was gained from our non-bus list and 1 sign will be given to each family. We are hoping to distribute all the signs this week. Once all the signs are given out we would be open to receiving requests for an additional sign. If you do not receive a sign by the end of this week, please call the main office and Mrs. Goven will print one out for you.

Our dismissal staff will look for these signs in order to match students with an appropriate ride home. We ask that you hang these signs on your mirror with the last name facing out towards onlookers. This is one additional step we can take to increase the safety and security of our students. Please be aware that if you do not have a sign we would look to take additional measures to ensure the students are entering an appropriate car.
