We continue to believe that parents are a vital part of our school culture and will maintain a focus on this positive partnership as we implement these recommendations.

# Valentine's Thank You

#### **Lunch Visitors**

Beginning this week Jennings School will adopt the district policy of only allowing lunch visitors on a student's birthday. We ask that you send in a note to your classroom teacher and/or call the main office to let is know you are coming in. We will be creating an appointment calendar for all of our visitors. If you fail to send in a note, we respectfully request a call by 9:30 AM in order to allow the secretaries to update the calendar. We will continue to have a separate table for you to enjoy the special lunch with your child(ren) only. Click the district letter link for more details. This change is described in #2 of the letter.

# **Other Visitors**

We ask that anytime you are planning to visit Jennings you send in a note to the main office through your classroom teacher. If it is an unscheduled visit or you forget to send in a note, please call the main office at 203-255-8316 to let us know you are coming in. This will greatly assist us with the new district protocols.

# Oops Cart

A second procedure change under the new safety and security recommendation involves each school having an "oops" cart. This cart will be placed outside of our front doors and should be used for those items you might have forgotten and need to pass along to your child. The cart will have a sign in sheet where you can list the time, item being dropped off and child's name and class. Before leaving you can press the buzzer and let the office know you have left something on the cart. The staff will retrieve items throughout the day. It is important to note that medications SHOULD NOT be left on the cart. Click on the district letter link for more details. This change is highlighted in #4 of the letter.

#### **Band and Orchestra**

Our procedure for before school rehearsals remains the same. Please be sure to be on time as practice begins promptly at 8:00 AM. There is limited staff available in the main office at that time and late arrivals should use Child Link entrance (in rear of building) if front door is not answered in a timely manner.

#### Dismissal in the back of Jennings

This is a friendly reminder that parking in the back of Jennings for dismissal is not an approved procedure. As mentioned in our Opening Day Guide and at Open House, picking up in back is prohibited. This is in place for several reasons, most of all for the safety of our students. We strategically have several students load their bus in the back for their safety. It is for this reason we ask that you find other ways to arrange dismissal plans. There are usually plenty of spots in our front parking lot and our carloop progresses very quickly from start to finish. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

#### **SBAC Presentations**

As March creeps up on us, we continue to work towards preparing for the new Smarter Balance Assessment Consortium field test.
