Car loop Dismissal

Our dismissal time is very busy time for staff and students. Although it is well organized and safe, there are things that we ask to assist us in providing safe transitions into your vehicles.

- 1. The use of cell phones is a very dangerous practice with little kids around. Please use hands free devices if you truly need to be talking while picking up your child.
- 2. The use of the signs handed out is very helpful for staff. If they are displayed on the rear-view mirror, the staff is better able to identify the connections for students. This assists with safety and efficiency.
- 3. Please have your children enter the car on the right side of the vehicle. At times cars are waved to pass on the left and we wish to keep all members of our community safe.
- 4. Car loop is not the appropriate type of pick up if an adult needs to exit the vehicle. All children should be able to get settled in their cars without support. If you feel like your child needs extra help please take an extra moment to park and pick them up at their door or in front of the building. We like to keep the carloop moving in an efficient manner to support the needs of our community.
- 5. If your child is not ready when you arrive into the loop, please place your flashers on and move forward and towards the right as directed by staff. This way cars who are ready to exit the loop have the opportunity while we await your child's arrival.
