- 4. If you are planning on sending a special guests as a visitor you must let us know and plan to have them present an ID.
- 5. Please DO NOT take your child out of school without signing them out at the main office. This is often an oversight during events that are towards the end of the day. It is imperative we know where all of our students are at dismissal.
- 6. Please work with your classroom teacher to ensure all parties are planned with our current FOOD policies and procedures in mind. We ask for diligence when it comes to safety of our students with life threatening food allergies. If you have any questions at all please do not hesitate to contact Mrs. Chapman or the main office for clarification.
