Word Work:

The new words for this week are: **play, do, go, where, with**. Please use the Word Wall menu to complete at least 3 activities this week.

Math:

We have started a new unit in math. Some of our class investigations are focusing on the strategies compensation and equivalence. Children may initially have a difficult time comprehending that $5+3$ is equivalent to $4+4$. The big ideas here are compensation and equivalence- that if you lose one (from the five, for example) but gain it (onto the three), the total stays the same. These big ideas, once constructed, allow children to realize that a problem like $6+8$ can be solved with a double, $7+7$.

You will be receiving your child's math assessment for our second unit of study. Please sign this and return it to your child's teacher the very next day. Thank you for your help with this.
