# Reading

We have continued to learn about fiction stories and to dive deep deeper into studying fictional characters. We have been noticing characters' external traits or appearance (eye color, hair color) and internal traits (brave, shy, persistent). We have learned that readers can pay attention to what characters say and do to determine their internal traits.

## Writing

This week we will continue working on Fiction writing. We have learned that fiction writers think of pretend characters, think of familiar settings and imagine adventures for their characters. We've also learned that writers can go back into their stories and work on their endings. One way they can work on their endings is to get their character out of trouble. Adding dialogue, action or feelings help to stretch out the ending.

#### Math

We are currently exploring time! Today we used what we have learned about fractions to help us learn more about the clock. We learned that when it is half past the hour, 30 minutes have gone by. We also learned that when it is quarter after or quarter past, 15 minutes have passed in the hour. At quarter of or quarter til, 45 minutes have passed and 15 minutes remain in the hour.
