Dear Parents:

It is with great excitement that I welcome you to the 2014-2015 school year at Mill Hill Elementary School! I've been busy over this summer getting ready for that first day which is just around the corner! I'd like to share some information with you to help make the school year begin successfully.

Our first day of school is **Thursday, August 28, 2014.** This year, **all students** will begin at **8:55 AM and will be dismissed at 3:30 PM, including kindergarten students.** There will be a PTA First Day Parent Reception in the APR at 9:15 AM.

Bus service to and from school will begin for all children on the first day of school. The bus routes will be posted in the local papers and on www.fairfieldschools.org. Please have your child at the bus stop at least five minutes before the scheduled pick-up time. Also, please be aware that the buses are often late the first few days, as the drivers typically are working to become familiar with their routes.

Students who ride the bus will enter the building through the front entrance where they are dropped off and walk directly to their classrooms. If you are driving your child, please be sure to use the *student drop-off area on the rear side* of the school (to the right). Staff members will be at both entrances to greet students and to help them find their classrooms. Students should not arrive at school prior to 8:45 AM. At the end of the day, all students will be dismissed to their buses. You must notify your child's teacher ahead of time if there is an alternate plan in place for dismissal (afterschool program, pick-up). If you plan to pick up your child at dismissal time, please park your car in a legal parking spot in the rear of the building and meet your child in the gymnasium.

As you know, the class placement process is thoughtful, collaborative, and takes into account your child's needs. We will not be able to accommodate any requests for a change of class placement. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

The three days before school starts are very busy for the teachers and staff. We have several meetings planned, and we ask that you respect this as time for teachers to use to get ready for our students. We will have two opportunities this year, however, for families to come to school prior to the first day. On Tuesday, August 26, at 4:30, we will be hosting the Grand Opening of the Kyle Winslow All Abilities Playground for all families past and present. Then, on Wednesday, August 27, at 11:00, we will be opening the school for students to visit their new teachers and see their classrooms! You are all invited to join representative members of the PTA and me in the APR for a welcome-back reception, beginning at 9:15 AM on the first day of school. See you then!
