## **LOOKING BACK**

**Object of the game**: To be the first student to cover 4 squares in a row – horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.

**Materials**: Hundreds chart, small markers to cover squares, and 3 dice

## **Procedure:**

- Play with a partner.
- Roll 3 dice. Use the 3 numbers to make true equations using addition, subtraction, multiplication or division.
- Cover the number on the game board that corresponds to the answer to the equation.
- Continue rolling the dice until one student has four squares in a row.

## **Extra Challenge:**

To make the game more challenging, try playing so that each square covered must touch the other.
