Dear Parents/Guardians,

North Stratfield is implementing a new cloud-based keyboarding program. This program was adopted by the middle schools for their 6th grade Computer Class this year and the district may choose to purchase it for all the elementary schools as well, depending on our experience and feedback.

Because the application is accessed online, all students can log in from home (or anywhere with internet connection) as well as school. This will allow students some much needed practice time that will "count" toward moving forward in the program.

All 2nd – 5th grade students have accounts and will be set up during their scheduled Tech Time. But feel free to log in anytime. The crucial element in practicing at home is the need for correct finger placement. We work hard on that in school and would like those practices to be continued at home. In elementary school, <u>correct finger placement and accuracy is much, much more important than speed</u>.

All student usernames are the same usernames students use to log into the computers at school. Students should know these. (first initial then last name – some have a number after their last name)

The password for everyone on TypingPal is tigers – all lowercase.

Each classroom teacher has a list of usernames if you are having trouble. We also have one in the LLC (Library Learning Commons)
