"Target tic-tac-toe"
Grades 4 and 5

This can be played in teams or with two players.

The object of the game is identical to tic-tac-toe.

Materials: 1 ten sided die, tic tac toe boards, 2 color chips or pencils/crayons

Decide who will be X and who will be O and choose the chips to represent each player.

- 1. X rolls the die twice. The first number on the die represents the tens place and the second roll represents the ones place. For instance: X rolls a 4 and the a 7. The number is then 47.
- 2. Team X then chooses a number between 1-9 to multiply the double digit number. For instance: Player X chooses 5 so he/she multiplies  $47 \times 5$  using any strategy.
- 3. Since the product of  $47 \times 5$  is 235, player X places his/her color chip or writes an X in the space marked 200 250.
- 4. Player O takes a turn.
- 5. The turns continue in this way until someone gets 3 in a row or the game board is filled up.
- 6. If a team gets a product that falls in the range of a square that is already marked with an X or an O, that team loses its turn.
