



ALL MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH STUDENTS

The Fairfield Public Schools has provided you with a summer work packet to help you be better prepared for your math course next year. To access the appropriate packet follow the directions below:

- Go to the district home page (www.fairfieldschools.org)
- Please direct yourself to the section “HOT DOWNLOADS AND LINKS”
- Choose the link “*Summer Math Packets*”
- Choose the appropriate math packet based upon the course entering (e.g., Algebra-8, Pre-Algebra-8, Pre-Algebra-7, Math-7, or Sixth grade packet for both Math-6 or Transition to Pre-Algebra)

As you will see, the format of the work packet is in a calendar design. The reason for this is that working on problems continually throughout the summer instead of just before school will help maintain the mathematical concepts and skills from the prior year.

Remember *this is a review and not new material*. This is to help you prepare for next year and to allow you to start the year by clearing up any background information necessary for success in your new math course. At the start of the school year, you will have an opportunity to correct and discuss these problems with your math teacher in class. For those without computer access, copies may be obtained in the main office of the incoming middle school. Please let the office know the course you are entering in the fall.
