Dear Parents/Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that we will be welcoming a new member to our school community. We anticipate that in mid-April, there will be a service dog at RLMS assisting one of our students. The dog, named Aliza Bean, will begin orientation at RLMS with a trained service dog facilitator following our April break.

Importantly, the purpose of service dogs is to perform work or tasks for their handler. Therefore, students, and those visiting the school or school activities, should not play with, pet, or otherwise interact with service dogs so that those dogs can do their important jobs. In addition, service dogs may not have any specific indicators identifying them as a service dog, so students and visitors should assume that any dog in the school is working, and therefore unavailable for interactions with others, unless informed otherwise. At RLMS, we have begun teaching students the expectations surrounding service dogs, including that service dogs are present to "work" and not as pets.
