<p>Book with One Author</p>	<p>Author's Last Name, First Name. <i>Title of Book (italicized)</i>. City of Publication: Publisher, Year Published. Medium of Publication (print, e-book, etc.)</p> <p>Example: Arnold, Tedd. <i>Fly Guy and the Frankenfly</i>. New York: Scholastic Inc., 2013. Print.</p>
<p>Book with More Than One Author</p>	<p>The first author's name is written Last Name, First Name but the other author names are written First Name, Last Name. The rest of the format is as above.</p> <p>Example: Gorman, Carol and Ron J. Findley. <i>Stumptown Kid</i>. Atlanta: Peachtree Publishers, 2005. Print.</p>
<p>On-Line Encyclopedia Article</p>	<p>Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." Title of <i>Encyclopedia</i>. Year of Publication. Publisher. Web. Date looked at.</p> <p>Example: Jackson, Keith. "Chesapeake Bay." <i>Encyclopedia Britannica</i>. 2006 ed. <i>Encyclopedia Britannica Online</i>. Web. 14 Sept. 2006.</p>
<p>Website (note: You may not always find an author or a month and year of publication!)</p>	<p>Last Name, First Name. "Website Article." <i>Website Title (italicized)</i>. Website Publisher, Date Month Year Published. Medium of Publication. Date Month Year you looked at it. (The URL (web address) is no longer required)</p> <p>Example: "France." <i>National Geographic Kids</i>. National Geographic Society, 2013. Web. 7 August 2013.</p>
<p>Video Viewed Online</p>	<p>"Segment Title." Director/Creator (if available). <i>Title of database or Website (italicized)</i>. Year of publication. Medium of Publication. Date Month Year you looked at it.</p> <p>Example: "The L-Team." Williams College Libraries. <i>YouTube</i>. 2007. Web. 27 August 2009.</p>
<p>Sound Recording</p>	<p>Artist Last Name, First Name. "Song Title." <i>Title of Album</i>. Publisher, Year of Publication. Medium of Publication.</p> <p>Example: Presley, E. "Jailhouse Rock." <i>Essential Elvis Presley</i>. BMG, 2007. CD.</p>
<p>Photograph Online</p>	<p>Photographer's Last Name, First Name (if available). <i>Photograph Title</i>. Year Created. Photograph. Museum/Institution/where kept (if applies). <i>Name of website in italics</i>. Medium of Publication. Date Month Year looked at.</p> <p>Example: Paley, Albert. <i>The Sentinel</i>. 2003. Photograph. Rochester Institute of Technology. <i>Google Images</i>. Web. 23 July 2009.</p>
