PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Educational

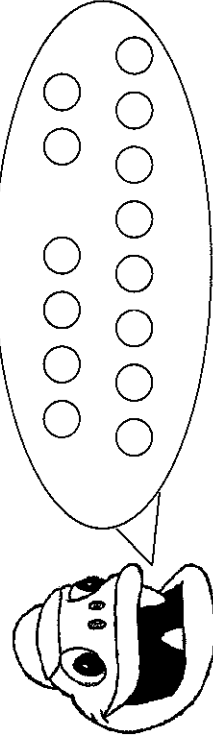

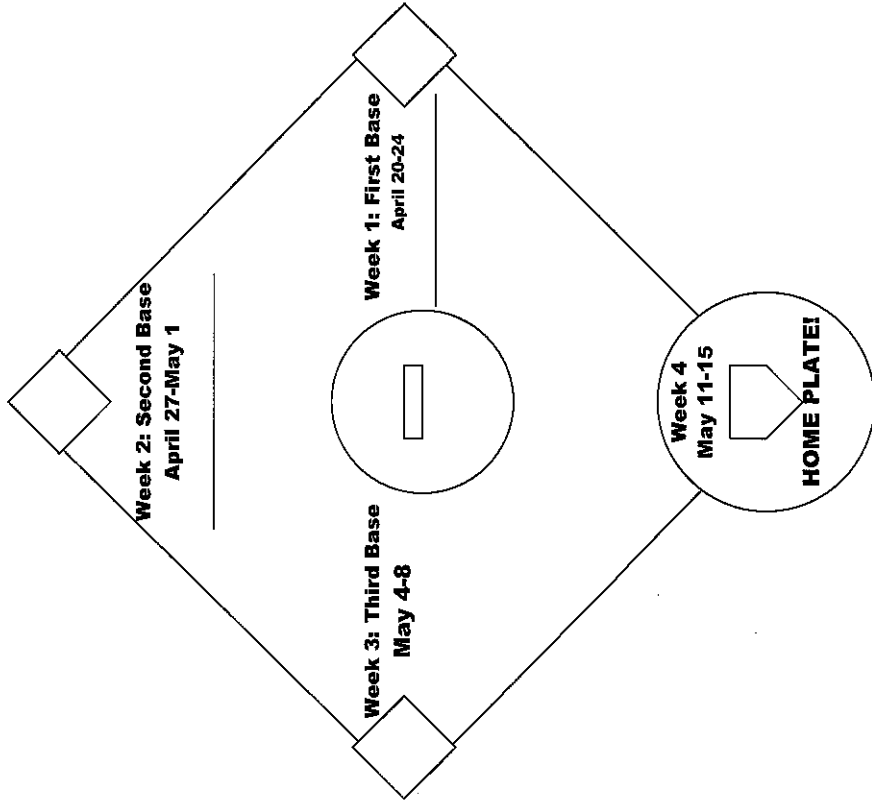
