Reader's Workshop

This week the students started to look at Fiction & Non-Fiction stories. We have been discussing what makes a story Fiction or Non-Fiction. Talk with your student at home about

different books you read together. Can they find evidence of a book being Fiction or Non-Fiction? Also, continue to emphasize checking the picture, asking

ourselves if the word looks right and sounds right! Encourage your student to Re-read until they feel it is right!!



<u>Math</u>

Our class was introduced to Math-Racks this week! Using this tool allows the students to see groups of numbers immediately and recognize the amount. Work at home with your student on seeing groups of numbers and asking them "how do you know there are that many?"
