**Organization is the biggest tool for our students. You can help:**

⇒ Set up a homework spot for your child. Include a bin with school supplies.

**Each weekend sit with your child as they**

⇒ go through their backpack to take care of any loose papers and things.

⇒ go through their binder to help them organize by subject area.

⇒ help them set up their assignment pad for the following week.

⇒ Check Infinite Campus with your child.

⇒ Contact teacher sooner than later.

⇒ Ask your child about missing assignments and long-term projects.

⇒ Ask your child about the Habits of Mind and goals set in school.

⇒ Join the PTA. The PTA does a great deal to support many TMS activities.

## How can I keep track of my child's progress?

- ◆ Look over your child's assignment pad on a regular basis. Is he/she writing everything down? There should be something written in every box.
- ◆ Register on Infinite Campus to keep track of your child's progress by monitoring student grades.
- ◆ Check the TMS Webpage often.
- ◆ Contact a specific teacher with any concern you might have. The easiest and quickest way is email.
- ◆ You may also call for an appointment with your child's school counselor.
- ◆ In short...PLEASE KEEP IN TOUCH WITH US. :)

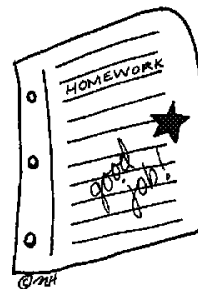


## Is there homework?
