In order to meet No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act requirements, schools are required to assess and document the technology proficiency level of all 8th grade students at the completion of each school year.

The portion of the NCLB Act known as 'Enhancing Education Through Technology Act of 2001' (E2T2) has as a goal: ***To assist every student in crossing the digital divide by ensuring that every student is technologically literate by the time the student finishes the eighth grade, regardless of the student's race, ethnicity, gender, family income, geographic location, or disability.***
