## 6th Grade Supply List

- 3 hardcover composition notebooks (no spiral)
- 1 one-subject spiral notebook
- 1 one-inch 3 ring binder
- 1 sturdy 3 inch 3 ring binder (suggested: zip around binder)
- 1 package of 8 durable pocket dividers
- 2 sturdy two-pocket folders
- 1 two-pocket folder with prongs
- Pencil pouch with holes for binder
- Backpack fyi; backpacks with wheels do not fit into our lockers
- Sturdy three hole punch

- 2 pkg. of wide-rule loose leaf paper\*
- 2 boxes of sharpened pencils\*
- 1 pkg. of blue or black ink pens\*
- 2 red or green correcting pens
- Highlighters\*
- Colored pencils\*
- Post-It notes\*
- 2 recent photos of yourself
- Useful but not required: calculator, a ruler with centimeters and inches, 1 one inch 3 ring binder, and 8 subject dividers for binder
