- Food – freeze dried served in bags – Yum!

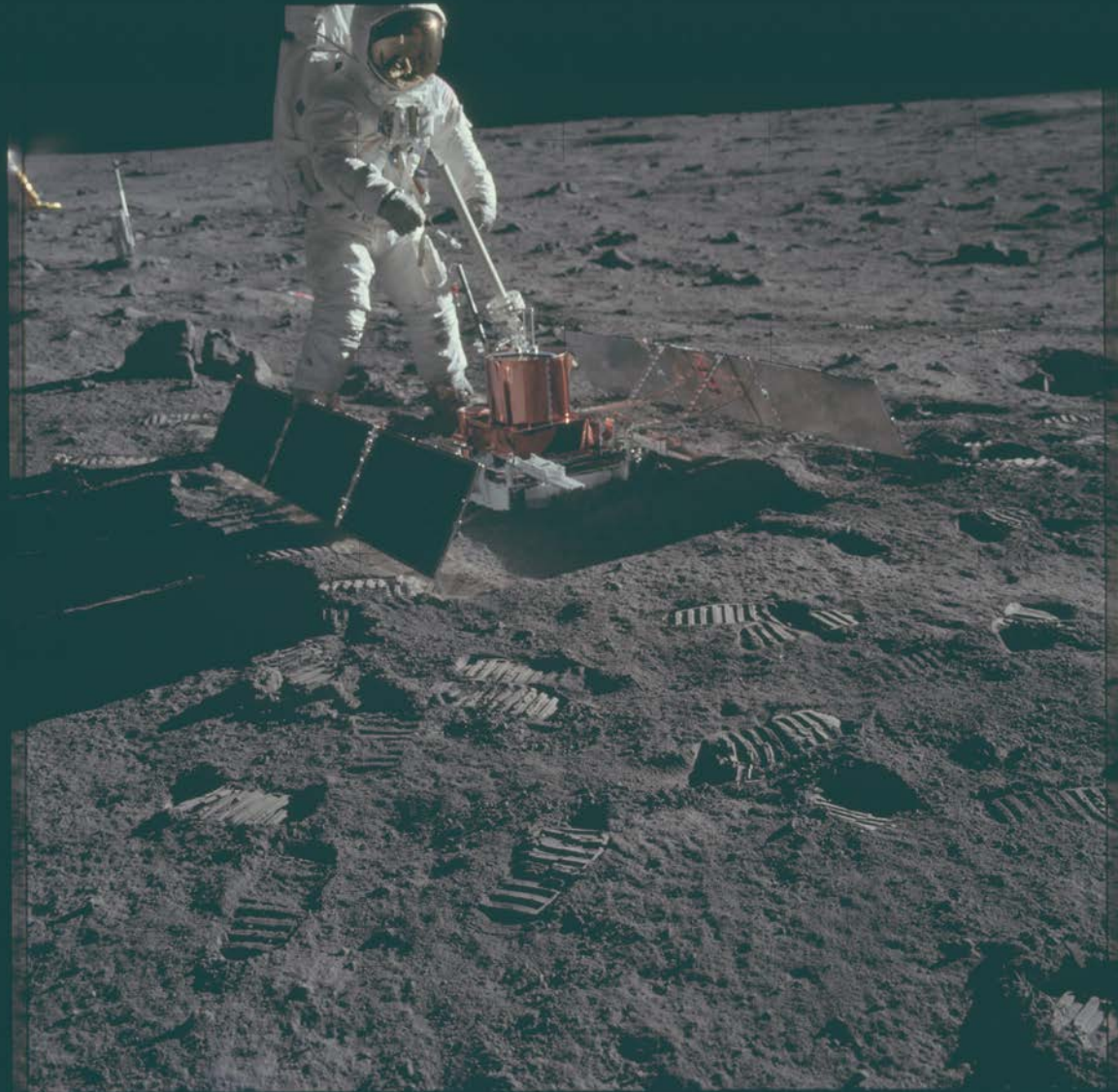
Space Suit

Eagle

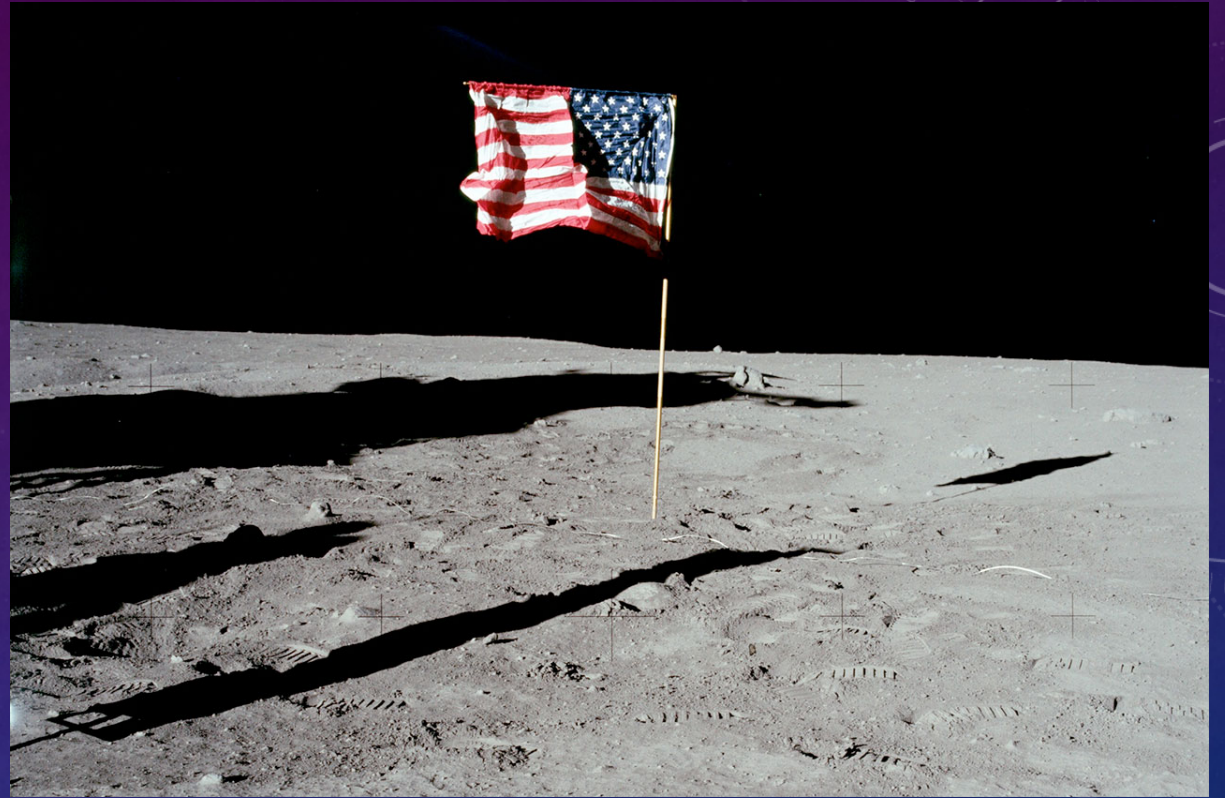
HOW DID THE ASTRONAUTS PREPARE?

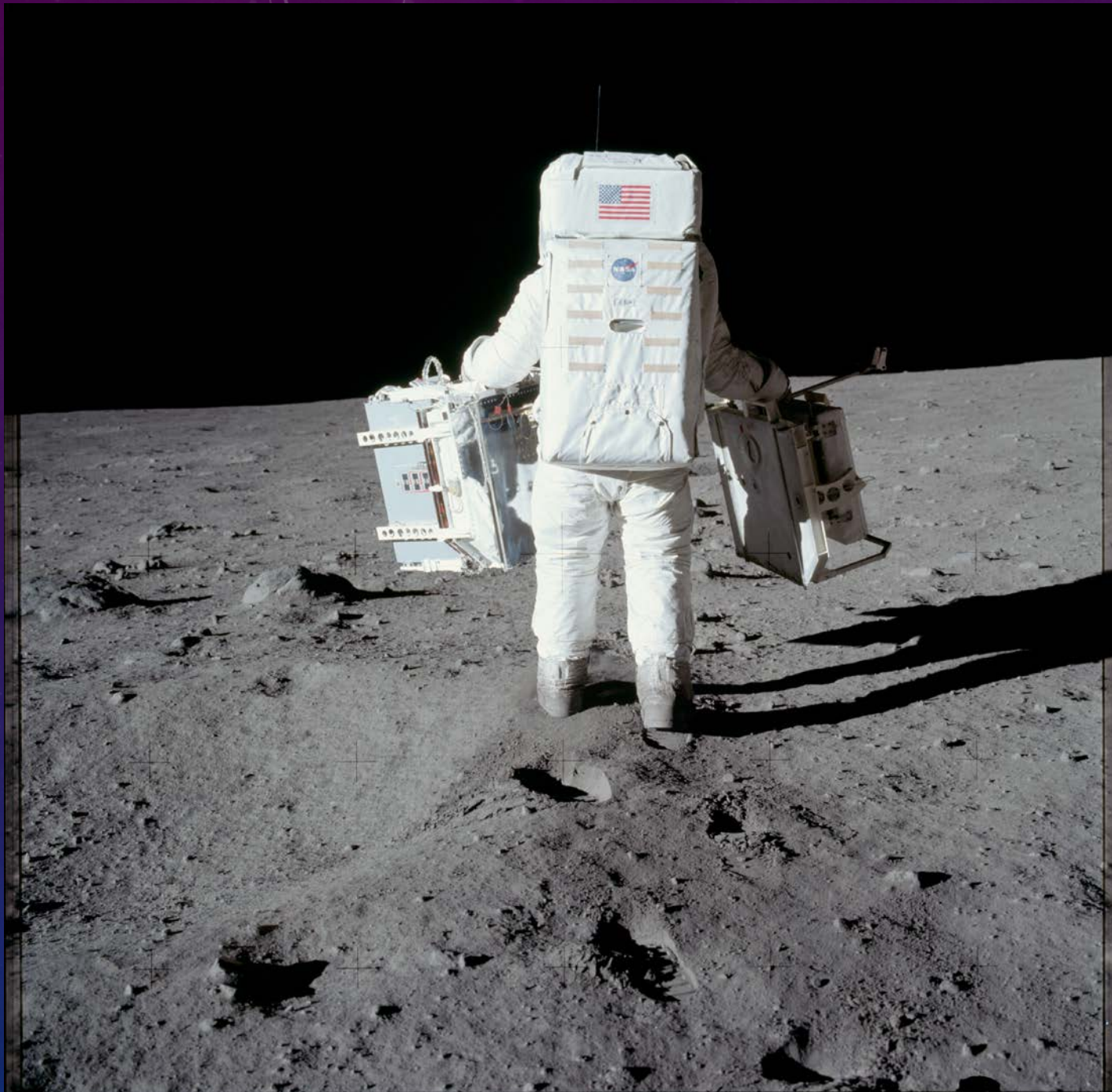
